

Homeless Leadership Coalition (OR-503 CoC) HUD CoC Grant Reallocation Process

Reallocation of Existing Funds

Due to HUD's severe FY 2015 CoC funding cuts, HLC will not require any program to reallocate funds in the FY 2016 competition because of unspent funds. However, HLC will reallocate funds from grantees who opt not to renew. Re-allocations will be for the same amount of funding as the existing CoC Program-funded projects. For example, if an applicant's current project receives \$100,000 in CoC Program funding, the re-allocation can be no more than \$100,000 in FY 2016 funding.

Other renewal projects included in HLC's Consolidated Application *may* be awarded more funding if any renewal projects fail to renew or if HLC re-allocates funds. This year, HLC will award re-allocated funds to existing programs. However, in future years, HLC may re-allocate funds in whole or in part from existing eligible renewal projects to create one or more new projects. CoCs may use reallocation to create:

1. New Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) projects where all beds will be dedicated for use by chronically homeless individuals and families, as defined by 24 CFR 578.3;
2. New Rapid Re-housing (RRH) projects that will serve homeless individuals and families, coming directly from the streets or emergency shelters, and include persons fleeing domestic violence situations and other persons meeting the criteria of paragraph (4) of the definition of homelessness;
3. New Supportive Services Only (SSO) projects specifically for a centralized or coordinated assessment systems; and
4. A new dedicated Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) projects for the costs at 24 CFR 578.37(a)(2) that can only be carried out by the HMIS Lead

All grantees should analyze their projects carefully to determine if re-allocation to a different component type makes sense, based on their current target population, physical configuration (e.g. dorm-style, scattered site), and community need.

HLC has communicated with all grantees regarding re-allocating. Grantees who wish to submit applications for re-allocated funds must submit applications in esnaps per the application process. We have posted links on HLC's website to assist applicants.
