
SERVICE-BASED LOCATIONS

Identify

All Shelters, Soup Kitchens, Mobile Food Vans in your community, and share this information using the GQ & TL Add Template.



Coordinate

Work with Census Bureau staff to ensure receipt of the most updated list of Service-Based Locations and Points-of-Contact.



Invite

Census staff to your meetings to present updates.



How You Can Help

Identify

Outdoor locations where the unhoused reside using the GQ & TL Add Template.



Recruit

Help the Census Bureau recruit staff who have worked with this population.



Update

The New Construction Program (Sept.-Nov. 2019) is an important chance for all localities to update information about homeless shelters.
