

## WHAT is the Point in Time (PIT) Count?

*A confidential survey of residents experiencing homelessness in Central Oregon.*

## WHO should take the survey?

*We will be surveying people who are in the following living situations:*

- *Sleeping outside*
- *Staying in a shelter or emergency housing*
- *Staying in a hotel or motel that's paid for by an agency or program*
- *Living in a vehicle, tent, camper, RV (with no hook ups), or abandoned building*
- *Living in a trailer, barn, shed or garage on a relative's or friend's property*
- *Temporarily living with relatives, friends, or others, or couch-surfing*

## WHEN is the PIT Count?

*Wednesday, January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Surveys may be conducted anytime between January 29<sup>th</sup> -31<sup>st</sup> on where people resided on the night of January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020.*

## WHY is there a PIT Count?

*The results of this count will help bring funds for services to Central Oregon so that we can help unsheltered families and individuals to obtain housing services. The PIT Count captures experiences and needs of our homeless population so that we can educate our community and improve services.*
