<b>DAY 52</b>	<b>Project Scoring by Independent Review Team (IRT)</b> IRT team is a formal review process where a committee of volunteers without conflicts of interest reviews all new/renewal applications and scores them to assist the grants committee.
<b>Day 65 ish</b>	<b>HLC Grants Committee Reviews IRT scoring and ranks projects</b>
<b>DAY 70</b>	<b>HLC Approval and Posting of Project Ranking</b>
<b>DAY 77</b>	<b>Grievance Deadline</b>
<b>DAY 90</b>	<b>HUD Final Deadline</b>
